*Bavaria*Israel* Workshop Series: EU Mission on Cancer

(EU Mission on Cancer – Submission Deadline: September 2024)

2 online working sessions (11 March & 14 March 2024)

The goal of the <u>EU Mission on Cancer</u> is to improve the lives of more than 3 million people by 2030, through prevention, cure and for those affected by cancer including their families, to live longer and better. The objectives include: (1) Understand; (2) Prevent what is preventable; (3) Optimise diagnostics and treatment; (4) Support quality of life; (5) Ensure equitable access in all aforementioned areas. Projects under this mission should contribute to setting out a credible pathway for implementing the Mission on Cancer. In 2024, the Commission estimates a total budget of 119 Mio. € for all topics under this mission.

This workshop on **selected topics** from the **EU mission on cancer** invites researchers from academia and R&D driven industry from Bavaria, Israel and other EU countries to explore new cooperation and network opportunities and to compose a one-pager as a feasible starting point for a HEU-proposal. The event is organized by experts of the <u>Bavarian Research Alliance (BayFOR)</u> and the <u>Israel-Europe R&I Directorate (ISERD)</u>.

What to expect? Among others, the workshop will address following questions: What are the goals and benefits of the EU-Mission on cancer? How to compose a convincing HEU- proposal? How to build a competitive consortium? Why (not) to become a HEU-coordinator? How to write a first draft and how to get the proposal writing process started? These and further questions will be addressed in our workshop session on selected topics of the EU-Mission "Cancer".
