The hybrid event has its focus on the framework conditions of European funding for research and innovation projects. "Horizon Europe" as the worldwide biggest funding programe for research & innovation (95 billions of € between 2021-2027) offers manifold options for projects in green topics, e.g. Decarbonisation, Environment, Food Value Creation, Circular Economy, Water, Climate Impact Research, Agriculture and Bioeconomy. Also partnes from outside Europe and the Global South (e.g. from Latin America, Africa and Asia) are eligible for being beneficiaries in European funded research and innovation projects
